

Regular meeting of April 3rd, 1961

The regular meeting of the Western Dubuque County Community School Board was held on Monday eve. April 3rd, 1961 at 8 P. M. at the office of the district in Farley.

Meeting called to order by President Driscoll.

Superintendent Drexler present also.

Minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved as so read.

A thank you note read from Mrs. Mildred Sefzik for a remembrance sent her by the board at the time of her illness.

Correspondence read from the Dubuque County Board of Education stating that the board had adopted the policy of maintaining the boundary line between Western Dubuque County Community School District and the unorganized portion of Dubuque County as approved at the time of the formation of Western Dubuque County Community School District except in cases of extreme hardships.

A motion by Deutmeyer that Superintendent Drexler be authorized to attend a school finance meeting in Minneapolis on April 7 and 8th. The motion seconded by Recker, motion carried unanimously.

Honoring a recommendation by Supt. Drexler, Deutmeyer moved that tuition and transportation payments for students attending schools outside of the district cease at the beginning of the 1961-62 school year. The motion seconded by Scherrman. The motion carried unanimously.

After much discussion on a salary schedule for bus drivers it was moved by Deutmeyer that: all school bus drivers for the district be paid a basic wage of \$130.00 (one hundred thirty dollars) per month of driving, plus \$1.00 (one dollar) per mile from the starting point of the bus to the point of delivery of the loaded bus at the designated school for any one trip per month. This total mileage, converted to dollars, is to be in addition to the basic wage of \$130.00, this amount includes and requires all

bus drivers to wash the bus inside and out once a week.  
This motion seconded by Scherrman. This motion carried  
unanimously.

It was moved by Recker that bills on order no. 11 be allowed,  
the motion seconded by Scherrman. The motion carried  
unanimously.

Motion by Deutmeyer that this meeting adjourn, seconded by  
Scherrman. Motion carried unanimously.
