

Regular meeting of September 7, 1961

The regular meeting of the Western Dubuque County Community School Board was held on Thursday eve. September 7, 1961 at the office of the district at the Farley Public School.

Meeting called to order by President Driscoll.

Minutes of the last regular meeting were read, they were approved as so read.

A Thank You note read from Msgr. Justin A Driscoll for kindnesses extended at the time of the death of his Mother.

The question of the source of electricity for the Bernard school was tabled for the present.

Scherrman reported that as yet he had not contacted Mr. Paul Thul in regard to obtaining additional property for the Farley Public School, but would do so in the near future.

A bill for labor and fencing materials had been received by the district from the St. Francis School District. After study of this bill Scherrman moved that the bill for the fencing materials in the amount of \$22.30 be paid the Armstrong Lumber Co. of Dyersville and the labor bill in the amount of \$250.00 be further investigated. The motion seconded by Recker and carried unanimously.

Correspondence read from the firm of O'Connor, Brooks, Ahrendt and Brooks, certified accountants who had audited the books of the Western Dubuque County Community School District. The letter stated that instructions had been given the secretary of the district to facilitate more accurate records of the district, also a

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recommendation that the secretary have an assistant. Superintendent Drexler told to proceed with the fulfillment of this recommendation.
