BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

Workshop Session

Thursday, March 5, 2015, 5:30 p.m.

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Conference Room – District Administration Office, Farley, Iowa.

Roll Call:

Present were Mark Knuth, Jeanne Coppola, John Lembezeder, Mark Tilson, and Superintendent Jeff Corkery. Absent was Chad Vaske.

Board member Chad Vaske joined the meeting at 6:15 p.m. and exited the meeting at 6:37 p.m.

Grade Alignment and Elementary Boundary Discussion:

Superintendent Jeff Corkery reviewed current elementary class sizes and projected 2015-2016 class sizes as well as current and proposed elementary attendance center boundary maps. Discussion on the impact the proposed boundary map change would have on class sizes at each of the highway 20 corridor elementary schools was discussed. Mr. Corkery indicated data would be reviewed to determine the number of families affected by the proposed boundary change and the information would be presented to the Board at the March 9, 2015 regular Board meeting. Mr. Corkery indicated if new elementary attendance center boundaries were adopted a decision would need to be made whether to “grandfather” currently enrolled students.
