

LATE BUS RUNS FOR AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Late school buses shall be provided to students participating in after school activities in the evening of days that school is in session and following the organized practice sessions for school activities. Buses will be operated for any Junior, Middle or Senior High School in the district, public or private, on a need basis.

The activity bus is not intended to provide door to door service. Students wishing to be brought to their rural homes are provided this service on the regular bus routes.

The transportation director will establish regular activity run stops:

Stops for activity buses will generally be limited to locations having the following characteristics.

- a.) a place to pull off the traveled portion of the highway such as a curbed city street or a parking lot.
- b.) some place where there is usually some type of public/private shelter available.
- c.) some means of contacting parents is normally available to students needing to do so.

Exceptions may be made for rural students who provide for the previously stated conditions of safety at a home, and who can group a number of students together voluntarily. A final decision to grant or deny this type of stop will be made by the Director of Transportation.
