Dear Peosta Families,

Halloween is fast approaching and we are preparing at Peosta Elementary School for a parade with our children on Wednesday, October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018.

We ask if you can, please bring in a *can of fruit to donate*. Canned fruit was requested by the Peosta Food Pantry, and would be greatly appreciated!

The parade will begin promptly at 8:45 A.M. Please do not arrive before 8:45 and we ask adults to stay outside, unless you have made prior arrangements with the teacher. You can park on the upper lot of the Rec Center and sit/stand on the grassy areas between the parking lot and school.

The parade will start in the inside of the building, led by Mrs. O'Brien, and continue through the school picking up each class at their door. After all classes have been assembled, the parade will continue through the recess doors and outside where we will take one lap around the front and go back in the gym doors.

Please carefully read the following information below to become familiar with our guidelines for this awesome day:

**NOTE:** If the weather does not permit us to go outside, we will hold the parade inside and will proceed through the gym for parents and guests to view the parade.

- Please choose a costume that does not reflect violence. Inappropriate "props" such as plastic swords, guns, knives and weapons of any kind are not allowed-even if they are part of your child's costume.
- No masks are to be worn to school or in the classroom but can be worn during the parade.
- No face paint or died hair that will distract from learning.
- Students should be able to put their costume over their clothing.
- All adults are asked to stay outside, unless you have made prior arrangements with the teacher.

Please discuss the guidelines with your child. Our expectation is to make this a wonderful experience for all of our students to remember!
