Regular meeting of December 1st. 1960

The regular meeting of the Western Dubuque County Community School Board was held on Thursday evening, December 1st, 1960 at 8 P. M. at the office of the district in the Farley Public School Building. Meeting called to order by the President of the district, Harold Driscoll.

Also present at the meeting: Superintendent Drexler and representatives of the architectural firm of Durrant and Berquist, and $^{\rm M}{\rm r}$. TaVerne Schiltz of the engineering firm of Cullen and Schiltz.

Copies of the minutes of the previous meeting having been sent the board members, it was moved by Deutmeyer and seconded by Ross that the reading of the minutes be dispensed with. Motion carried unanimously.

Bills on order no 7 were presented; included in the presentation of the bills was the application of membership for "The Iowa Center for Research in School Administration"---- a motion by Ross that the bills be allowed, the motion seconded by Deutmeyer and carried unanimously.

The architects and ^{M}r . Schiltz reported to the board at this time on their surveys and findings of proposed school sites.

After discussion, a motion by Ross that: Attorney Reynolds be engaged to obtain options on four lots near the Cascade East Side School if possible, also on property across the street from the school, including in the motion that: the engineers make the necessary surveys and findings on this property. Motion seconded by Deutmeyer and carried unanimously.

Following discussion on the proposed Bernard site, it was moved by Ross that: Mr. Drexler accompany Attorney Reynolds and contact the owner of suitable school site property in Bernard and obtain options on five acres of the suitable land if at all possible, if an option on five acres could not be obtained to see if an option on four acres might be had. This motion also including the provision that——— the engineers report on surveys and findings on this property if options were obtained. Motion seconded by Scherrman and carried unanimously.

After deciding to meet on the next day--- December 2, 1960 at 1 P. M. to look at additional school sites, a motion by Scherrman that this meeting adjourn, seconded by Ross. Motion carried unanimously.
