After many weeks of discussion and study on the building program and enrollment of the district, including the kindergarten enrollment in the Dyersville area, Scherrman moved that:

the bond quota of the school building program consisting of building and furnishing a junior-senior high school building at Epworth Iowa, elementary schoolhouses at Cascade, Bernard and Dyersville, and an addition at Farley Iowa and procuring sites thereof be set at one million three hundred and thirty three thousand five hundred dollars, (1,333,500.00).

Also that the bond quota for the purpose of building a school bus garage be set at eleven thousand five hundred dollars, (11,500.00).

Motion by Ross that bills on order no 10 be allowed. The motion seconded by Scherrman and carried unanimously.
