

Regular meeting of June 7, 1962

The regular meeting of the Western Dubuque County Community School Board was called to order at 8:00 P. M. on Thursday June 7, 1962. Meeting called to order by President Driscoll.

Superintendent Drexler present also.

Minutes of the previous meeting read, a motion by Deutmeyer that they be accepted as read. Motion seconded by Recker and carried unanimously. Mr. Heim was present demonstrating the Forney welder. The Board decided that the welders which are to be installed in the shop would be placed on bids at a later date.

Mr. Robert Kirpes met with the board at this time giving information and displaying the Fischer venetian blind products. No decisions are to be taken on blinds or draperies for the new buildings for some time.

Mr. Mormann of Cascade was present. Mr. Mormann is very much interested in the position of custodian at the Cascade School if a vacancy should occur in that position. Mr. Mormann to be notified definitely on this matter within a week.

A motion by Deutmeyer that: the motion of May 3rd, 1962 stating one hundred dollars per month would be paid for custodian work at the Cascade School, be rescinded, and moved that the salary for this position be one hundred twenty five dollars per month.

Mr. Wilfred Gross of Cascade had been offered the contract on this position at one hundred dollars per month. The motion seconded by Recker and carried unanimously.

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It was moved by Deutmeyer that Mr. John Urban of Peosta be given a bus drivers contract, subject to his meeting the requirements of Public Instruction. Motion seconded by Recker and carried unanimously.

In view of the fact that the work of the maintenance man, Mr. Al F Thillen would be decreasing as the new centers opened in the fall of the 1962-1963 school term, it was moved by Deutmeyer that: Mr. Thillen be offered a contract for \$340.00 for the months of July, August, September and October, and on November 1st, his salary be reduced to \$100.00 per month, as he would then be placed as custodian of the Dyersville Kindergarten building. The motion seconded by Recker and carried unanimously.

Superintendent Drexler authorized to offer a contract for \$100.00 per month for school custodian at Bernard.

On June 5th bids had been opened on the Public Address and Intercom system, the following bids had been submitted:

A motion by Recker that change order no four with Frey Construction Co. in the amount of a + \$270.00 be allowed. Motion seconded by Deutmeyer, motion carried unanimously.

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Superintendent Drexler reported to the Board that he would be getting to each member an estimate of the budget for the ensuing year. The date of the budget hearing having been set as July 24th. A motion by Recker that the following contracts be given for the 1962-1963 school year.
