## **PTO Meeting Minutes**

Balance: \$20,275.97 in the checking account.

Therapy Dog – Mr. Wendler and Ms. Kraus, Special Ed Pathways instructor, would like to look into getting a therapy dog for school. Ms. Kraus has a one-year old dog, Remy, they would like to train and certify. They are asking if PTO would be willing to pay for the training with Stone Hollow and the therapy certification. They are thinking it will be around \$3,000. Ms. Kraus is meeting with Tory from Stone Hollow on Thursday to see if he thinks Remy would even be an option. PTO agreed to have Ms. Kraus move forward and meet with Tory and see what he says. A contract would need to be signed with a certain number of years Ms. Kraus and Remy would have to remain at CES or all fees would need to be returned to CES PTO. They are hoping to have numerous handlers trained.

Steph Zalaznik talked to Decker's again and they will donate the money to purchase the string cheese. Lisa Aschtgen will reach out to Sue Knepper to see if an option to order through school, if not, will purchase from Sam's Club. Would need around 300. Mr. Wendler will order banner once all businesses have sent in their logos. Weekly prizes — cookout (hot dog and chips), ice cream party or pizza party. Cookout can be an option each week, pizza party is only available to be picked once.
