THREATS OF DANGER

As soon as a threat of danger is reported to the administration, the school district facility should be cleared immediately if law enforcement officers have been involved with the investigation and recommend such action. A thorough search will be made by the appropriate school district or law enforcement officials. Employees and students will remain in a designated area until it is determined that danger no longer exists. Such threats that require students to lose instructional time in school will be made up at a future time determined by administration and school board.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent to file a report or keep a report of each incident for the school district records.
