
Complementary Colored Hearts



What colors complement each other?

Remember, they are opposite of each other on the color wheel!



Above is an example of a finished Complementary Colored Hearts project

Directions: Start with the box in the top left corner. Choose which set of complementary colors you want to start with. In the example, it is orange and blue. Inside the first line, it is colored orange, but the area inside of the heart is colored blue. The next line is the exact opposite. The outside is colored blue but inside the heart is colored orange. You continue with that pattern until the entire area is colored.
