PSAT – Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship

The (PSAT/NMSQT) qualifying test is a multiple-choice test that measures verbal and mathematical reasoning abilities important to doing college work. There are two twenty-five minute verbal sections, two twenty-five minute math sections and one thirty minute writing skills section. As a junior, if you earn very high scores on these tests, you will qualify for the opportunity to enter scholarship competitions administered by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation. Taking the PSAT/NMSQT as a junior is the only way a student may enter competition for the National Merit Scholarships. The test is administered in October.
