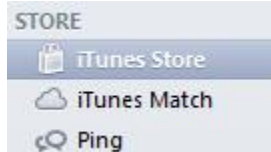




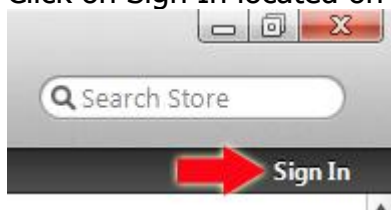
Creating an iTunes Store, App Store, iBookstore, and Mac App Store account without a credit card

If you have not created an Apple ID yet, this article will assist you in doing so on your computer in iTunes.

1. Launch iTunes on your computer.
2. Click iTunes Store (on the left side of the iTunes window)



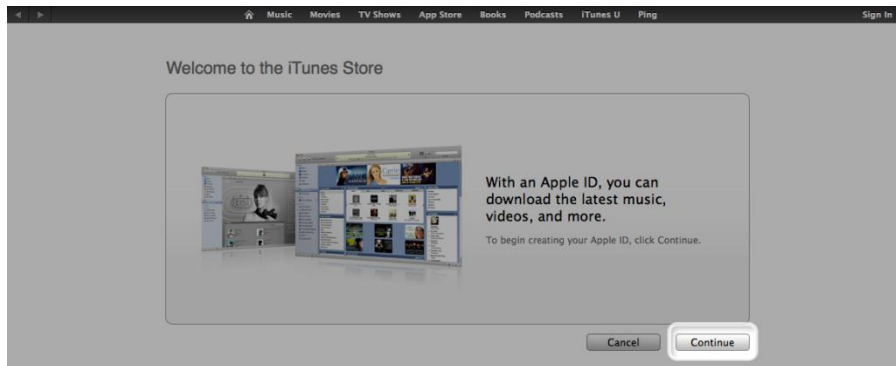
3. Click on Sign In located on the upper right of the iTunes Store application



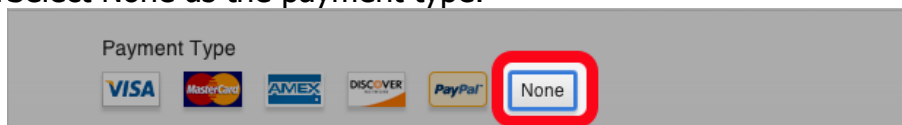
4. In the pop-up window, click Create Apple ID.



5. You are directed to the "Welcome to the iTunes Store" screen. Click Continue.

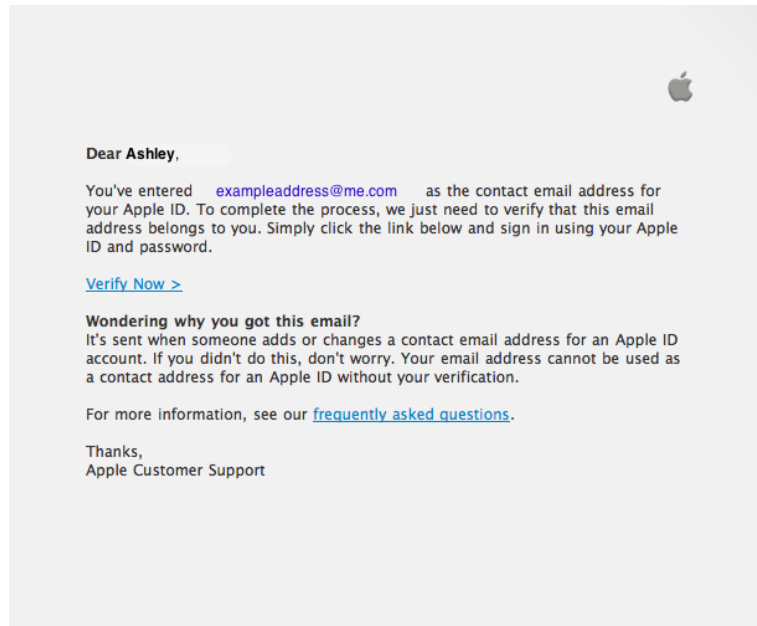


6. You'll need to read and agree to the iTunes Store Terms & Conditions. Make sure you check the box next to "I have read and agree to these terms and conditions."
7. Click Continue.
8. Enter your email address, create your password, continue to create and answer your security questions, and then enter your birthday.
9. You can also enter an optional rescue email address. If you frequently change email addresses, this is recommended.
10. Once you are satisfied with the information entered, click Continue.
11. Select None as the payment type.



12. Continue to fill out the required name and address fields.
13. You'll then see a "Verify your Account" screen. Click Done, and then check your email for a verification email from iTunes Store.

14. Open the email, and click the link enclosed in the email to activate your account.



15. Once you click on the link, the Apple ID website should ask you to sign in with your account name and password.
16. After signing in, you should see that your email address is associated with your Apple ID. A button labeled "Return to the Store" should appear.
17. Once you sign in, you'll then see the below "Congratulations" screen. Click Start Shopping to be taken to the App Store home page.
